

TEACHERS IN CONVENTION.

NEW-BRUNSWICK, N. J., Nov. 23.—The Middlesex County Teachers' Institute this morning commenced its three-day session. There were about 180 of the 190 teachers present. County Superintendent H. B. Willis presided. Prof. Ryan, the Superintendent of this city's public schools, made the address of welcome. Mr. Willis, Superintendent of the Perth Amboy schools, responded. After the various committees had been appointed the morning was spent in listening to papers read by Miss M. C. Coy of South Amboy and Mr. Roberts of Dunnellen. Several papers were read in the afternoon, and Prof. Green of the State Normal School gave some practical instructions in school works. The Rev. J. R. Mace made an instructive address in the evening.
