PLAINFIELD, N. J., July 28.—Charles T. Vail, Postmaster of Velley, Hunterdon County, N. J., is lying in a dangerous condition, unconscious, with a fractured skull and half of his body paralyzed, at the home of M. B. Smalley, in Dunellen, as the result of being thrown from a trolley car last night. He had been to Bound Brook and was returning to Plainfield, where he was visiting, when at a sharp curve between Bound Brook and Dunellen he was thrown headlong to the highway.
