

The Dunellen Disaster Investigation.

EASTON, Penn., Jan. 13.—Superintendent Spriggs of the Lehigh Valley Railroad and Trainmaster Harleman began the examination to-day of witnesses to fix the responsibility for the wreck at West Dunellen, N. J., on Monday last, when seventeen lives were lost. The hearing was behind closed doors, and a number of witnesses were heard. No announcement will be made of the proceedings until all the testimony is in.
