

FREIGHT TRAIN WRECKED.

**Broken Wheel Causes Five Cars to
Pile Up at Dunellen, N. J.**

PLAINFIELD, N. J., July 9.—A broken wheel on a Philadelphia & Reading Westbound freight train wrecked five empty cars and derailed three cars loaded with rolls of paper at Dunellen, N. J., late this afternoon, blocking three of the four tracks for several hours. No one was injured.

When the wheel broke the empty cars were piled on top of each other and the tracks were torn up for some distance.
